Quick-start pouch, project pickers, and safety checklist

Quick Start: Build Your Grab-and-Go Pouch

What to pack

- Small project bag or pouch
- Travel scissors (blade under 4 inches)
- Project tools (hook, needles, hoop)
- Tiny notebook or index cards
- Pen or pencil
- Small trash or zip bag for scraps
- Earbuds for music or podcasts

Pro tip: Wind a small bobbin of yarn or thread and bring 1–2 colors only.
Less to carry means more travel crafting.

Pick Your Travel Craft

Small knitting project (socks, hat, scarf)	Tiny coloring kit (pencils + cards)
Crochet square or dishcloth	English paper piecing (hexies)
Mini embroidery hoop (3–4 in)	Friendship bracelets
Zentangle or doodle sketchbook	Plastic canvas / mini needlepoint
Urban sketching (pen + brush pen)	Pocket watercolor set

Travel safety and quick pattern card

Travel Safety Checklist

- Tools covered; no sharp tips exposed
- Blunt tapestry needle if possible
- Scissors under 4 inch blade length
- Yarn/threads clipped; no loose tangles
- Quiet kit (no rolling beads)
- Field of movement clear in tight seats
- Breaks to stretch every 10 minutes
