

Craft Corner Planner — Plan Your Small-Space Setup

Step 1: Pick Your Craft Corner

Choose one spot. Keep depth 24–30 in. Use zones for each hobby.

Room or Wall Location

Primary Hobby (sewing, paper, painting, etc.)

Surface Choice (desk or fold-down) and size

Lighting Plan (lamp, window, task light)

Step 1B: Simple Zones

Give each category a home. Keep the work surface clear.

- ☐ Wall Zone (pegboard above surface)
- ☐ Door Zone (clear-pocket organizer)
- ☐ Mobile Zone (3-tier rolling cart)
- ☐ Closet/Under-Bed Zone (lidded backstock bins)
- ☐ Desk/Surface Clear Rule after each session

Vertical Storage — Pegboard & Back-of-Door Organizer

Step 2: Pegboard Layout

Hang daily tools. Move parts as projects change.

Must-Have Tools (scissors, rulers, cutter)



Hook Plan (how many, what goes where)



Small Shelf Contents (thread, jars, tape)



Add-Ons (cup holders, trays, bins)



Step 3: Back-of-Door Organizer Map

Assign small items to clear pockets. Label by category.

Markers Pockets



Glue Sticks Pockets



Washi Tape Pockets



Small Paints Pockets



Stamp Pads Pockets



Trims Pockets



Embellishments Pockets



Needles Pockets



Small Tools Pockets



Step 4: Rolling Cart Plan

Top: daily tools and current project. Middle: thread/paints. Bottom: scraps/backups.

Step 6: Budget Bins & Shelves

Pick one-size bins for stacking. Repurpose shelves and jars.

- ☐ Repurpose shelves you own
- ☐ Dollar-bin containers (one size)
- ☐ Magazine files for paper/vinyl
- ☐ Jars/cans for brushes/needles
- ☐ Clear labels on all bins

Weekly Reset — Inventory & Shopping Checklist

Weekly Reset Routine

Keep surface clear, refill bins, and update labels.

- ☐ Clear desk and put tools back on pegboard
- ☐ Refill cart top with current project only
- ☐ Check door pockets for overflow
- ☐ Consolidate empties and relabel as needed
- ☐ Wipe surfaces and sweep floor

Inventory Top-Ups

Track backstock so you do not overbuy.
